An Act To Amend the Charter of the Dover and Foxcroft Water District

(EMERGENCY)

Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not 2 become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

- Whereas, this legislation increases the number of trustees of the Dover and Foxcroft Water District from 3 to 5; and 6
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Whereas, the trustees are to be elected at the district's

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annual meeting, which is held in February; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts 12 create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately 14 necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. P&SL 1985, c. 107, Pt. B, §3 is repealed and the 20 following enacted in its place:

2.2 Sec. 3. Territorial limits; corporate name. Pursuant to the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 35-A, section 6403, subsection 1, paragraph B, that part of the Town of Dover-Foxcroft described as 24 follows: beginning at the point of intersection of 45 degrees, 26 12 minutes, 30 seconds north latitude and 69 degrees, 11 minutes, 26 seconds west longitude; thence due south to 45 degrees, 11 minutes, 29 seconds north latitude; thence due west to 69 28 degrees, 12 minutes, 12 seconds west longitude; thence south to 45 degrees, 10 minutes, 30 seconds north latitude; thence west to 30 69 degrees, 16 minutes, 00 seconds west longitude; thence north 32 to 45 degrees, 12 minutes, 01 seconds north latitude; thence east to 69 degrees, 13 minutes, 45 seconds west longitude; thence north to 45 degrees, 12 minutes, 30 seconds north latitude; 34 thence west to the point of beginning; and its inhabitants constitutes a standard water district under the name "Dover and 36 Foxcroft Water District," referred to in this Act as "the 38 district."

Sec. 2. P&SL 1985, c. 107, Pt. B, §6, as amended by P&SL 1999, c. 27, \S and 4 and affected by \$9, is repealed.

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Sec. 3. P&SL 1985, c. 107, Pt. B, §6-A is enacted to read:

Sec. 6-A. Trustees. The board of trustees of the district is composed of 5 trustees. A trustee must be a resident of 46 Dover-Foxcroft. The trustees holding office on the effective date of this subsection hold office as trustees for the terms for 48 which they were elected, and as each term expires one trustee must be elected by the registered voters of the district at the 50

	next annual meeting of the district to serve for a term of 3
2	years. The additional 2 trustees must be elected at the next
	annual meeting, one for a term of 2 years and one for a term of 3
4	years. If a vacancy arises, it must be filled for the remainder
	of the unexpired term. The trustees are entitled to compensation
б	for their services as determined by the trustees. The trustees
	may also adopt bylaws as necessary for their own convenience and
8	the proper management of the affairs of the district and may
	procure an office and incur expenses as necessary.
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	Sec. 4. P&SL 1985, c. 107, Pt. B, §§11 and 12 are repealed.
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	Sec. 5. P&SL 1985, c. 107, Pt. B, §14, sub-§1 is repealed and the

32	take, hold, divert, use and distribute water from Salmon Stream

26	surface or underground brook, stream, spring or vein of water in
36	Dover-Foxcroft.
38	Sec. 8. Transition; trustees in office. Trustees of the Dover and
30	Foxcroft Water District in office on the effective date of this
40	Act may continue in office for the remainder of their terms.
10	When the term of office of a trustee expires, that trustee's
42	successor is elected in accordance with Private and Special Law
	1985, chapter 107, Part B, section 6-A.
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	Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the
46	preamble, this Act takes effect when approved.

SUMMARY

2 The bill amends the territory of the Dover and Foxcroft 4 Water District and increases the number of trustees of the board of trustees of the Dover and Foxcroft Water District from 3 6 trustees to 5 trustees.
