COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A' to S.P. 609, L.D. 1677 subsection may not reapply until the license has been expired at 2 least one year. A motor vehicle dealer who holds a vehicle auction business 4 license under section 1051 is exempt from this subsection. 6 A motor vehicle dealer who engages primarily in the sale of 8 classic vehicles, emergency vehicles or industrial or farm equipment is exempt from this subsection.' 10 12 **SUMMARY** 14 This amendment changes the title of the bill to accurately 16 reflect its new provisions. 18 This amendment changes the minimum sales requirement of 12 vehicles in order to obtain a renewal of a dealer license by removing the restriction to retail sales only. 20 This amendment also exempts dealers engaged primarily in the sale of emergency 22 vehicles or industrial or farm equipment as well as classic vehicles, the last of which the bill proposed for exemption, from 24 the minimum sales requirement.
