This amendment is the majority report. It clarifies that the Employee Suggestion System Board has exclusive authority to make awards and all decisions are final. It requires the board to forward all suggestions to the Office of Program Evaluation and Government Accountability a minimum of 2 times per year. It also permits the board to establish administrative fees through the rule-making process. The amendment also adds an effective date of January 1, 2005.
