Further amend the bill in section 1 in that part designated "**§6025-A.**" in the first paragraph in the 2nd line from the end (page 1, line 16 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "<u>privileges</u>" the following: '<u>and immunities</u>'

Further amend the bill in section 1 in that part designated "**§6025-A.**" in the first paragraph in the last line (page 1, line 17 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "<u>privileges</u>" the 12 following: 'and immunities'

14 Further amend the bill in section 1 in that part designated "§6025-A." by inserting at the end the following indented 16 paragraph:

18 '<u>The commissioner shall immediately notify the Secretary of State of New Hampshire if this section is repealed or amended to significantly alter its application.</u>'

Further amend the bill by striking out all of section 2 (page 1, lines 19 to 26 in L.D.) and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 2. Contingent repeal date; reciprocal legislation. This Act is repealed if the Maine Commissioner of Marine Resources certifies to the Secretary of State and submits a copy of that certification to the Office of the Revisor of Statutes that the State of New Hampshire has repealed the New Hampshire Revised Statutes Annotated, Title XXII, chapter 270, section 270:12-e or amended that section so that it is no longer substantially the same as the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 12, section 6025-A as enacted in this Act.

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#### **SUMMARY**

42 This amendment adds an emergency measure and clarifies that when New Hampshire marine patrol officers are investigating 44 potential terrorist activities in Maine waters of the Piscataqua River or Portsmouth Harbor those officers are entitled to the 46 same immunities granted to Maine marine patrol officers. The amendment contains a conditional repealer that takes effect if 48 New Hampshire repeals its reciprocal statutory language. Finally, the amendment requires the Commissioner of Marine
