Sec. 3. Retroactivity. That section of this Act that amends the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 37-B, section 3, subsection 1, paragraph D applies retroactively to September 1, 2001.

SUMMARY

In 1993, the United States Congress authorized the "Department of Defense STARBASE Program" and authorized the Department of Defense to enter into agreements with the states for the purpose of conducting programs designed to improve the knowledge and skills of students in mathematics, science and technology. This bill authorizes the establishment of a STARBASE program in this State.
