SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P.  
625, L.D. 1693, Bill, "An Act To Improve the Property Boundary  
Marking Laws for Purposes of Timber Harvesting"

Amend the amendment in section 1 in that part designated  
"~~§2511.~~" in subsection 3 in paragraph B in the last line (page 2,  
line 36 in amendment) by striking out the following: "and"


Further amend the amendment in section 1 in that part  
designated "~~§2511.~~" in subsection 3 in paragraph C in the last  
line (page 2, line 43 in amendment) by striking out the  
following: "emergencies." and inserting in its place the  
following: 'emergencies; and'

Further amend the amendment in section 1 in that part  
designated "~~§2511.~~" in subsection 3 by inserting after paragraph  
C the following:

'D. Timber harvesting performed on a parcel of land that is  
5 acres or less.'

SUMMARY

This amendment provides an exemption for timber harvesting  
performed on a parcel of land that is 5 acres or less.
