8	1. Definitions. As used in this section, unless the context otherwise indicates, the following terms have the following meanings.
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12	A. "Common property" means anything with value that is undivided and jointly owned by 2 or more people.
14	B. "Cutting" means cutting, chopping, sawing or felling.
16	C. "Established property line" means a line demarcated by monuments, signs, markings, pins, reference points or other
18	markers that denotes a change in ownership between abutting properties. These established property line markers must
20	have been placed upon mutual agreement of the abutting landowners, based on historical physical evidence of a
22	preexisting boundary line, or by a licensed professional surveyor pursuant to Title 32, chapter 121.

50	2. Prohibitions. The following acts are prohibited.
4.0	2. FIGHIDICIONS. The following acts are promibiled.
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42	A. A person who fails to mark property lines in accordance with this paragraph commits a civil violation. A landowner,
	landowner representative or designated agent who authorized
44	<u>timber harvesting or in fact cuts or harvests timber shall</u> <u>clearly mark any established property lines that are within</u>
46	200 feet of the area to be cut. The marking of property lines must be completed prior to commencing the cutting or
48	timber harvesting operations.

B. A landowner, landowner representative, designated agent
or harvester who authorizes or in fact cuts or harvests a
line tree without first obtaining permission from the
abutting owner commits a civil violation.

- 6 **3. Exemptions.** The following are exempt from this section:
- 8 <u>A. The Department of Transportation in the performance of</u> activities under Title 23, section 701;
- B.Public utilities engaged in maintaining adequate12facilities in emergencies in compliance with Title 35-A,
section 301; and

C. Municipal employees, persons contracting with a municipality or other legitimate agents of a municipality acting within the course and scope of their employment or performing volunteer work for the municipality by removing trees obstructing a public way or fallen trees or in emergencies.

SUMMARY

This bill:

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Requires persons cutting or harvesting trees near a
property boundary line to clearly mark the property boundary line;

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30 2. Prohibits the cutting or harvesting of trees growing on a property boundary line unless prior approval is obtained from 32 owners of the abutting property; and

34 3. Provides an exemption for tree cutting performed by the
Department of Transportation, public utilities or municipal
