When appropriate, this report may be combined with any transplantation report required under subsection 1, paragraph D. SUMMARY

This amendment requires the Commissioner of Marine Resources to submit a written report by January 1st of each year to the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over marine resources matters and the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over inland fisheries and wildlife matters describing the status of all current and planned programs, activities and rules of the department pertaining to the conservation or management of state endangered or state threatened marine species. Additionally, it requires the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife to include the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over marine resources matters when the commissioner submits the commissioner's annual report on threatened and endangered species to the joint standing committee of the Legislature having
