subject to judicial review of final agency action in the
manner provided by Title 5, chapter 375, subchapter 7. If a
registered owner files an appeal pursuant to this
subsection, the authority may not notify the Secretary of
State to suspend the registration certificate and plate
issued for the vehicle involved in the alleged failure to
pay until the appeal is resolved.'

SUMMARY

8 This amendment provides that a toll evader has a 30-day period either from the receipt of a notice of liability or, in 10 the case of an appeal, from the final decision of the Maine Turnpike Authority on the appeal or from the final adjudication 12 of liability in Superior Court in which to pay any applicable tolls, administrative fees and penalties. If the toll evader fails to pay all applicable tolls, administrative fees and 14 penalties, the registration of the vehicle owner will be The amendment removes the provision from the bill 16 suspended. that would allow the Secretary of State, upon receipt of notice from the Maine Turnpike Authority, to suspend the registration 18 and plates of a toll violator without providing written notice to 20 the vehicle owner. This amendment also provides that an image that shows the face of a person may not be used by the Maine Turnpike Authority for the purpose of collecting tolls and fines 22 for nonpayment of tolls.
