HOUSE AMENDMENT "B" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 643, L.D. 1711, Bill, "An Act To Require That a Directory Listing of a Commercial Toll-free Number Include an Address"

Amend the amendment in section 1 in that part designated "~~S1250-L.~~" in subsection 1 in the 2nd line (page 1, line 43 in amendment) by striking out the following: "person" and inserting in its place the following: 'business offering consumer goods for sale in this State'

SUMMARY

This amendment provides that the prohibition against local misrepresentation applies to businesses offering consumer goods for sale in this State.
