26	that calls to the numbers do not in any way connect callers to the business.'

30	Further amend the amendment in section 1 in that part designated " <b>§1250-L.</b> " in subsection 3 in the last 2 lines (page 2, lines 15 and 16 in amendment) by striking out all of the last
32	sentence.
