Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
Sec. 1. 14 MRSA §6048-A is enacted to read:
<u>§6048-A. Required terms</u>
An agreement described in section 6047 must contain,
clear and understandable language, the following terms an conditions:
1. Lease fee. The amount of any lease fee and what t
<u>lease fee covers;</u>
2. Roads, maintenance. The responsibilities of the less
and lessor regarding roads and other maintenance;
3. Contact person. The designated contact person of t
lessor to whom a concern of the lessee may be communicated; and
4. Other fees. The amount and explanation of any oth
<u>fees such as liability insurance.</u>
SUMMARY
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This bill requires a lease between a person who owns land
territory under the jurisdiction of the Maine Land Use Regulati
Commission and a person who owns one or more buildings on th
land to include certain specific terms and conditions. Und
this bill, such a lease must contain, in clear and understandab
language, agreed-to terms regarding the lease and other fee
road and maintenance responsibilities and the designated conta
person for the lessor.

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
