Amend the amendment by striking out all of section 2 and 20 inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 2. Funding. Resolved: That the State House and Capitol 22 Park Commission may seek and accept outside sources of funding for the purposes of section 1. Prompt notice of solicitation and 24 acceptance of funds must be sent to the Executive Director of the Legislative Council. All funds accepted must be forwarded to the 26 Executive Director of the Legislative Council along with an accounting record that includes the amount of funds, date the 28 funds were received, from whom the funds were received and the 30 purpose and any limitation on the use of the funds. The Executive Director of the Legislative Council administers any funds received; and be it further 32
