	This bill is a concept draft pursuant to Joint Rule 208.

	The purpose of this bill is to ensure that severance pay is
10	paid to the former employees of Great Northern Paper Company,
	which filed for Chapter 11 bankruptcy protection on January 9,
12	2003. This bill would require that Inexcon Maine, Great
	Northern's parent company, pay severance pay in accordance with
14	the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 26, section 625-B to the former
	employees of Great Northern Paper Company.
