2	Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §11553 is enacted to read:
-	§11553. Moose management within high-accident areas
б	Notwithstanding section 11552, the commissioner may suspend
8	the rule-making procedure to respond to the need to increase the number of moose permits within an area that is experiencing a
10	significant increase in the number of accidents involving a vehicle colliding with a moose.

16	This bill gives the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife the authority to forgo the rule-making procedure when
18	responding to the need to increase the moose harvest due to an increase in moose-related vehicle accidents.
