SUMMARY

This bill amends the laws concerning optional membership for 4 participating local districts in the Maine State Retirement System to parallel changes made for state employees in the system 6 in Public Law 2003, chapter 261. This bill allows service credit to be purchased for the period during which an individual in the 8 service of a participating local district opted not to be a member of the Maine State Retirement System if that individual 10 rejoins the system. The bill also provides that when an employee in the service of a participating local district who terminated 12 membership in the Maine State Retirement System subsequently rejoins, that employee may repay those withdrawn contributions 14 plus interest immediately upon restoration of service.
