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SUMMARY

Committee Amendment A creates the Fund to Encourage Racing 18 at Maine's Commercial Tracks and distributes 4% of the gross slot machine income to this fund.

This amendment removes the fund and the distribution to that fund and instead increases the distribution to the University of Maine System Scholarship Fund by one percent to 3% and the Maine Community College System to fund scholarships by one percent to 2%. The balance, 2%, is distributed to the program established to provide low-cost prescription and nonprescription drugs, medication and medical supplies to disadvantaged, elderly and disabled individuals.

Fiscal Detail and Notes

This amendment has no net effect on Other Special Revenue Funds. The deletion of the Fund to Encourage Racing at Maine's Commercial Tracks will decrease the Other Special Revenue Funds allocations and revenues for the Department of Agriculture, Food and Rural Resources by \$633,957 in fiscal year 2004-05. These losses will be offset by increases in Other Special Revenue Funds allocations and revenues of \$158,489 in fiscal year 2004-05 for both the Finance Authority of Maine and the Maine community College System and an increase of \$316,979 in revenues and allocations for the Department of Human Services.
