

#### **Fiscal Detail and Notes**

There are no net changes in Other Special Revenue Funds allocations and revenues. Other Special Revenue Funds allocations and revenues will be reduced by \$158,489 for the Department of Agriculture, Food and Rural Resources in fiscal year 2004-05; this loss will be offset by an equivalent gain in allocations and revenue for the Baxter Compensation Authority during the same fiscal year.
