2 The University of Maine System Scholarship Fund is created and established as a nonlapsing fund under the jurisdiction and control of the Board of Trustees of the University of Maine 4 System. All revenues credited to this fund must be distributed 6 as need-based scholarships for students attending the University of Maine System. These scholarships may be awarded only to those 8 students who are residents of the State. The fund may not be used for the costs of administering the scholarships. Amounts 10 credited to the fund pursuant to Title 29-A, section 456, subsection 2, paragraph A may not be distributed as scholarships 12 to students attending the University of Maine.

Sec. C-2. 20-A MRSA §11631, as amended by PL 2001, c. 623, 14 §3, is repealed.

Sec. C-3. 29-A MRSA §456, sub-§2, ¶A, as amended by PL 1995, 18 c. 645, Pt. A, \S^2 and affected by \S^18 , is further amended to read:

Fourteen dollars to the University of Maine System 20 Α. Scholarship Fund established in Title 20-A, section 11631 22 10909; and

Sec. C-4. Transfer of funds. Any funds remaining in the fund 24 formerly held by the Finance Authority of Maine in the University of Maine System Scholarship Fund established in former Title 26 20-A, section 11631 must be transferred to the Board of Trustees of the University of Maine to be deposited in the University of 28 Maine System Scholarship Fund established in Title 20-A, section 10909. 30

SUMMARY

This amendment repeals the University of Maine Scholarship 14 Fund currently held by the Finance Authority of Maine and creates an identical fund to be administered by the University of Maine 16 System Board of Trustees. Two percent of the total gross slot machine income will go to the new fund, rather than the repealed 18 fund, for the same purpose.
