20	Sec. 1. City of Biddeford authorized to consolidate voting districts. Resolved: That, notwithstanding the Maine Revised Statutes,
22	Title 21-A, section 631, the City of Biddeford, with the approval of the city council, may consolidate voting districts for the
24	purpose of holding a special election in House District 18 in 2004. The plan to consolidate districts must be submitted to the
26	Secretary of State at least 10 days prior to the special election.
