PART P

Sec. P-1. PL 2003, c. 469, Pt. H, §1 is amended to read:

30 Sec. H-1. Transfer. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the State Controller shall transfer \$53,000,000 a total of \$43,000,000 from the unappropriated surplus of the General Fund 32 to the Dirigo Health Fund in a manner to be determined in consultation with the Executive Director of Dirigo Health but in 34 no case later than June 30, 2004.

Sec. P-2. Retroactivity. Section 1 of this Part applies retroactively to September 13, 2003.' 38

Further amend the amendment by relettering or renumbering 40 any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively. 42
