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E. Agree to keep-each provide inpatient for-no-longer-than care for a period that does not exceed, as determined on an annual, average basis, 96 hours,-unless-a-longer-period-is required-because-of-inclement-weather-or-other-emergency conditions-or-a-Peer-Reviser-Organization,-"PRO"-or-other equivalent--entity,---on---request,---waives---the---96-hour restriction per patient; and

Sec. DD-2. Jackman Region Health Center. The Department of Human Services shall promptly take whatever steps are necessary to facilitate the qualifying of the Jackman Region Health Center as a critical access hospital.

14 Sec. DD-3. Rules. The Department of Human Services shall adopt rules to implement this Part. Rules adopted pursuant to this section are routine technical rules as defined in the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 5, chapter 375, subchapter 2-A.'

Further amend the amendment by relettering or renumbering 20 any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

SUMMARY

26 This amendment updates the state definition of "critical access hospital" to be consistent with the new federal definition 28 as set forth in the federal Medicare Prescription Drug, Improvement, and Modernization Act of 2003. The amendment also 30 requires the Department of Human Services to take whatever steps are necessary to qualify the Jackman Region Health Center as a 32 critical access hospital.
