The new members added are a representative of the 16 Maine Chiefs of Police Association, representatives from domestic 18 violence and sexual assault victims service providers, the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife and 2 Legislators: one Senator representing the 2nd-largest political party in the 20 Senate and one representative representing the 2nd-largest 22 political party in the House. The amendment also clarifies that legislators may continue to serve on the commission, even if not 24 reelected to serve in the Legislature in November 2004. 26 FISCAL NOTE REQUIRED

## **Fiscal Note**

Current Costs - Legislative Study

## Legislative Study

The projected legislative costs to extend the Commission To Improve the Sentencing, Supervision, Management and Incarceration of Prisoners and add two additional members are \$1,260 in fiscal year 2003-04 and \$3,780 in fiscal year 2004-05. Other expenses attributable to the extension may be paid from the remaining balance of the original appropriation to the Department of Corrections for the Commission. The Legislature has budgeted \$20,000 in fiscal year 2004-05 for legislative studies. Whether the amount is sufficient to fund all studies, including the fiscal year 2004-05 legislative costs of this bill, will depend on the number of studies authorized by the Legislative Council and the Legislature.
