An Act To Amend the Charter of the Mount Desert Water District

(AFTER DEADLINE)

(EMERGENCY)

Presented by Representative KOFFMAN of Bar Harbor. Cosponsored by Senator DAMON of Hancock and Representatives: BLISS of South Portland, DUPLESSIE of Westbrook, Senator: HALL of Lincoln. Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

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Whereas, the election of trustees of the Mount Desert Water District will occur before the end of the current legislative session; and

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Whereas, the charter restrictions on the eligibility of trustees pose an immediate disturbance in the management of the district; and

Whereas, the water district must be managed consistently to 14 provide for the health and safety of its customers; and

16 Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of 18 Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and 20 safety; now, therefore,

22 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

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Sec. 1. P&SL 1993, c. 83, §9, sub-§4 is amended to read:

- 26 4. Vacancy. Whenever the term of office of a trustee expires, the trustee's successor must be elected at large by a 28 plurality vote by the inhabitants of the district. For the purpose of election, a special election must be called and held 30 on the first Monday in May or on such other date in May as the trustees establish, the election to be called by the trustees of 32 the district in the same manner as town meetings are called and for this purpose the trustees are vested with the powers of 34 municipal officers of towns. The trustee so elected shall serve the full term of 3 years. If any vacancy arises in the 36 membership of the board of trustees, it must be filled in like manner for the unexpired term by a special election to be called 38 by the trustees of the district. When any trustee ceases to be a resident of the district, the trustee shall vacate the office of trustee and the vacancy must be filled as provided in this 40 All trustees are eligible for reelection, but a-person section. 42 who-ic--a-municipal-officer-in-the-Town-of-Mount-Decert-ic-not eligible-for-nomination-or-election-as-trustee no more than 2 trustees may be municipal officers of the Town of Mount Desert. 44
- 46 **Emergency clause.** In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this Act takes effect when approved.

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2	SUMMARY
4	This bill amends the charter of the Mount Desert Water District. A municipal officer in the Town of Mount Desert is not
6	eligible to be a trustee under the charter. The bill allows no more than 2 municipal officers to be trustees.
