Whereas, the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 5, chapter 375, subchapter 2-A requires legislative authorization before major substantive agency rules may be finally adopted by the agency; and

- Whereas, the above-named major substantive rule has been submitted to the Legislature for review; and
- Whereas, immediate enactment of this resolve is necessary to record the Legislature's position on final adoption of the rule;

16 Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of 18 Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and 20 safety; now, therefore, be it

Sec. 1. Adoption. Resolved: That final adoption of Portions of Chapter 755: Health Insurance Classifications, Disclosure and Minimum Standards, a provisionally adopted major substantive rule of the Department of Professional and Financial Regulation, Bureau of Insurance that has been submitted to the Legislature for review pursuant to the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 5, chapter 375, subchapter 2-A, is authorized.
