SUMMARY

This amendment approves the major substantive rules 26 submitted regarding MaineCare rates for private nonmedical institutions provided those rules are amended to use a 25-cent per resident per day rate reduction in the facility-specific 28 routine component of the room-and-board portion of the payment in place of the reduced reimbursement, based on application of a 30 bed-hold day decrease, that had been proposed. The amendment requires wording used to refer to reimbursement related to 32 foreign exchange fellows of professional exchange programs for 34 social workers to be changed: "stipend" must be changed to "contract fee."

- The amendment requires the Department of Human Services to 38 adopt emergency rules to implement the rules as approved by the Legislature.

Fiscal Detail and Notes

The amendment revises the original bill/rulemaking to replace the implementation of a rate reduction for medical and remedial PNMI bed-hold days (as included in PL 2003, c. 20, Pt. B), with a \$0.25 per resident per day reduction in room and board payments. Assuming the bed-hold day provision remains in effect until the \$0.25 per resident per day reduction in room and board payments becomes effective, there would be no net impact on the General Fund. There would be an increase in Federal Expenditure Funds allocations and revenue because the c. 20 reduction in MaineCare spending would be replaced with a reduction in state-only spending.
