
HOUSE AMENDMENT 'A' to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "B" to S.P. 723, L.D. 1875, Bill, An Act To Authorize Department of Transportation Bond Issues in the Amount of \$18,250,000 To Match Available Federal Funds for Improvements to and Development of Highways and Bridges; Airports; Ferry Vessels, Port Facilities and Marine Infrastructure; Rail Corridors and Structures; Intermodal Facilities; and Trail and Pedestrian Facilities"

Amend the amendment in Part D in section 6 by inserting after subsection 6 the following:

'7. Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, the Land for Maine's Future Board may use bond proceeds to purchase public land and easements for more than the appraised value only when exigent circumstances exist, as determined by the Commissioner of Conservation, and with the approval of the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over conservation matters.'
