HOUSE AMENDMENT "C" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "B" to S.P. 723, L.D. 1875, Bill, "An Act To Authorize Department of Transportation Bond Issues in the Amount of \$18,250,000 To Match Available Federal Funds for Improvements to and Development of Highways and Bridges; Airports; Ferry Vessels, Port Facilities and Marine Infrastructure; Rail Corridors and Structures; Intermodal Facilities; and Trail and Pedestrian Facilities"

Amend the amendment in Part D in section 6 by inserting after subsection 6 the following:

'7. The Land for Maine's Future Board shall use a portion of the funds to negotiate with the North Maine Woods Association and landowners in other parts of the State for the removal of gates or other restrictions on public access to large tracts of land in this State.'

Further amend the amendment in Part D in section 6 by renumbering the subsections to read consecutively.

Further amend the amendment in Part D in section 7 in the last blocked paragraph in the last line (page 11, line 50 in amendment) by inserting after the following: "preservation" the following: 'and to negotiate for the removal of restrictions on public access to large tracts of land in Maine'

Further amend the amendment in Part D in section 11 in the question in the 5th line (page 12, line 35 in amendment) by striking out the following: "preservation," and inserting in its place the following: 'preservation and to negotiate for the removal of restrictions on public access to large tracts of land in Maine,'
