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SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1399, L.D. 1883, Bill, "An Act To Coordinate Education, Job Training and Employers in Maine"

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Amend the amendment by inserting after the title and before the first paragraph the following:

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'Amend the bill in section 2 in that part designated "§13060-G." in the first paragraph in the first line (page 1, line 21 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "The" and inserting in its place the following: 'Beginning in fiscal year 2005-06, the' '

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Further amend the amendment in the first paragraph after the title in the first line (page 1, line 22 in amendment) by striking out the following: "Amend" and inserting in its place the following: 'Further amend'

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Further amend the amendment on page 2 by striking out all of subsection 2 (page 2, lines 12 to 16 in amendment) and inserting in its place the following:

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'2. Chair; vice-chair. The member representing the Department of Economic and Community Development, appointed by the Commissioner of Economic and Community Development, shall serve as the chair of the S.W.A.T. team. A member who is elected from among those appointed under subsection 1, paragraph A, subparagraph (1) or (2) or paragraph B shall serve as the vice-chair of the S.W.A.T. team.'

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Further amend the amendment by striking out all of section 11 and inserting in its place the following:

Fiscal Detail and Notes

Beginning the marketing strategy in fiscal year 2005-06 will reduce the General Fund cost of the bill by \$75,000 in fiscal year 2004-05. As amended, the Department of Economic and Community Development will require General Fund appropriations of \$75,000 annually beginning in fiscal year 2005-06 for the Business Development program within the department to contract for services to develop and implement a comprehensive marketing strategy.

As amended, this bill will require General Fund appropriations to the Legislature in the amount of \$2,520 annually beginning in fiscal year 2004-05 to provide funds for the per diem and expenses for legislative advisory members of the Future for Youth in Maine State Work Action Tactics team (S.W.A.T team)
