Sec. 1. Directing Public Utilities Commission to implement universal rural broadband Internet access statewide. Resolved: That the Public Utilities Commission shall develop and implement a plan to provide universal rural broadband Internet access statewide by January 15, 2006; and be it further

Sec. 2. Reporting date established. Resolved: That the Public 8 Utilities Commission shall report on its plan and the status of implementation to any policy-making body established in state law 10 to direct a coordinated effort to develop, streamline and oversee the State's economic development policy and specific efforts to 12 retain and attract young people and to the joint standing the Legislature having jurisdiction committee of over telecommunications matters no later than September 8, 2005 and 14 every 6 months thereafter until implementation is complete.

## SUMMARY

20 This resolve directs the Public Utilities Commission to develop a plan to implement universal rural broadband Internet 22 access statewide by January 15, 2006. The Public Utilities Commission is directed to report on this initiative no later than 24 September 8, 2005 and every 6 months thereafter until implementation is complete.
