COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1410, L.D. 1906, Bill, "An Act To Amend the Protection from Harassment Laws"

Amend the bill in section 2 in subsection 1 by striking out the last 2 sentences (page 2, lines 2 to 5 in L.D.)

Further amend the bill in section 4 in subsection 1 by striking out the last paragraph (page 2, lines 25 to 31 in L.D.)

Further amend the bill by striking out all of section 9.

Further amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

**SUMMARY**

This amendment deletes 3 provisions from the bill.

1. It deletes the requirement that a plaintiff first report the harassment to a law enforcement agency before seeking a protection from harassment order.

2. It deletes language concerning case management conferences and alternative dispute resolution.

3. It deletes the authorization to charge the plaintiff for court costs and attorney's fees.
