The provision that should be repealed is Title 35-A, section 3211-B, which relates to energy programs previously transferred from the Department of Economic and Community Development to the Public Utilities Commission. These responsibilities are modified by chapter 644 and moved to the new chapter 95 in Title 35-A. This amendment corrects the error in the public law.
