HOUSE AMENDMENT "C" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1420, L.D. 1919, Bill, "An Act To Make Supplemental Appropriations and Allocations for the Expenditures of State Government and To Change Certain Provisions of the Law Necessary to the Proper Operations of State Government for the Fiscal Years Ending June 30, 2004 and June 30, 2005"

Amend the amendment by striking out all of Part NNN.

Further amend the amendment by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.
