28 3. Payment by State. The State shall pay a percentage of the retired teacher members' share of this insurance according to 30 the following schedule:

32 A. Thirty percent until July 1, 2002;

34 B. Thirty-five percent from July 1, 2002 to July 31, 2003; and

C. Forty percent after July 31, 2003.

Effective April 1, 2004, the State makes a solemn contractual commitment to each vested teacher that the percentage of the vested teacher's share of health insurance to be paid by the State will be no less than the percentage committed at the time the teacher met the applicable creditable service requirement for eligibility to receive a retirement benefit, at the applicable age if so required, under Title 5, section 17851.
