SENATE AMENDMENT "H" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1420, L.D. 1919, Bill, "An Act To Make Supplemental Appropriations and Allocations for the Expenditures of State Government and To Change Certain Provisions of the Law Necessary to the Proper Operations of State Government for the Fiscal Years Ending June 30, 2004 and June 30, 2005"

Amend the amendment by inserting at the end before the emergency clause the following:

PART FFFF

Sec. FFFF-1. Transfer for potato blight prevention.

Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the Treasurer of State shall transfer on the effective date of this Part \$750,000 from the Department of Professional and Financial Regulation, Bureau of Insurance, Other Special Revenue Funds account to the Department of Agriculture, Food and Rural Resources, which must use the funds for the purchase of potatoes at the rate of \$1.50 per hundredweight for the prevention of potato blight. By July 1, 2005, the Treasurer of State shall transfer \$750,000 to the Department of Professional and Financial Regulation, Bureau of Insurance, Other Special Revenue Funds account from the General Fund.'

Further amend the amendment by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.
