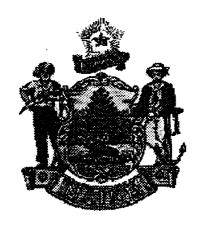

This amendment will increase the General Fund cost of the bill by \$1,976,704 in fiscal year 2003-04 and will decrease the General Fund cost of the bill by \$2,310,639 in fiscal year 2004-05.
