SENATE AMENDMENT "C" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 767, L.D. 1930, Bill, "An Act To Promote Intergovernmental Cooperation, Cost Savings and Efficiencies"

Amend the amendment by striking out all of sections 9 and 10.

Further amend the amendment by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

SUMMARY

This amendment removes the provisions of Committee Amendment "A" that would allow a charter commission to be initiated by the county commissioners or by petition by voters. Under this amendment the question of whether to establish a county charter commission would still be submitted to the voters.
