Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

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Sec. 1. P&SL 1991, c. 26, §4, last sentence, as amended by PL 1997,
4 c. 696, §6, is further amended to read:

6 School administrative units shall submit requests for upgrades
under this section to the Department of Education before ~~July-1,~~
8 1999 August 31, 2004.

10 **Sec. 2. Retroactivity.** This Act applies retroactively to June
30, 1998.

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SUMMARY

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The purpose of this bill is to extend the time by which
18 school units may request upgrades to higher classifications for
educational technicians employed before September 1, 1991 who are
otherwise eligible for upgrade under the provision of law enacted
20 by Private and Special Law 1995, chapter 35.
