HOUSE AMENDMENT "B" to H.P. 1446, L.D. 1946, Bill, "An Act To Promote the Coordination of School Calendars for Career and Technical Education Students"

Amend the bill by striking out the title and substituting the following:

'Resolve, To Promote the Coordination of School Calendars for Career and Technical Education Students'

Further amend the bill by striking out everything after the title and before the summary and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 1. Regional school calendars. Resolved: That the Commissioner of Education shall adopt rules to provide guidelines for those school administrative units that seek to establish regional school calendars that align the school calendars of sending schools with the school calendars of career and technical education programs in the region. Rules adopted pursuant to this section are major substantive rules pursuant to the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 5, chapter 375, subchapter 2-A.'

SUMMARY


This amendment replaces the bill and changes it to a resolve. It requires the Commissioner of Education to adopt rules to establish guidelines for school administrative districts

Fiscal Detail and Notes

This amendment removes the mandate to school administrative units that required the development and approval of a regional plan for a common school calendar by September 2005.

As amended, the additional costs to the Department of Education associated with rulemaking can be absorbed utilizing existing budgeted resources.
