## **ORDERS**

(4-1) On motion of Representative MUSE of Fryeburg, the following Joint Order: (H.P. 1044) (Cosponsored by Senator: HASTINGS of Oxford)

ORDERED, the Senate concurring, that the Joint Standing Committee on Inland Fisheries and Wildlife shall report out, to the House, an emergency bill to permit limited reciprocity with New Hampshire for registration of snowmobiles operated on trails approved by the Maine Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife that are located partly in Maine and partly in New Hampshire. The reciprocity must be limited to the extent necessary to allow riders to reconnect with their respective in-state trail systems in areas where the trail cannot be easily relocated entirely in either state.
