
HOUSE AMENDMENT "F" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 6, L.D. 1, Bill, "An Act To Increase the State Share of Education Costs, Reduce Property Taxes and Reduce Government Spending at All Levels"

Amend the amendment in Part D in section 58 in subsection 1 in paragraph B in subparagraph (1) (page 54, line 2 in amendment) by striking out the following: "~~84%~~" and inserting in its place the following: '55%'

Further amend the amendment in Part D in section 63 in that part designated "~~\$15753.~~" in the first indented paragraph in the 3rd line (page 70, line 19 in amendment) by inserting after the following: "provide" the following: 'for fiscal year 2005-06 55% of a school administrative unit's special education costs as calculated pursuant to section 15681-A, subsection 2 and beginning in fiscal year 2006-07 and thereafter'

SUMMARY

This amendment changes the state funding percentage of a school unit's special education costs from 84% to 55% for fiscal year 2005-06. The savings generated by this change are distributed to school units through the funding formula.
