HOUSE AMENDMENT "I" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 6, L.D. 1, Bill, "An Act To Increase the State Share of Education Costs, Reduce Property Taxes and Reduce Government Spending at All Levels"

Amend the amendment in Part D by inserting after section 68 the following:

Sec. D-69. Fund for Efficient Delivery of Educational Services; approval of legislative committees. Notwithstanding the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 20-A, section 15754, allocations of funds from the Fund for the Efficient Delivery of Educational Services may be used by the Office of Program Evaluation and Government Accountability for program evaluation and assessment of costs relative to the provision of educational services upon the approval of the Joint Standing Committee on Education and Cultural Affairs and the Government Oversight Committee established pursuant to the Joint Rules of the 122nd Legislature, Rule 371.'

Further amend the amendment in Part D in section 73 in the 2nd line from the end (page 75, line 13 in amendment) by striking out the following: "71" and inserting in its place the following: '72'

Further amend the amendment by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.
