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

Fiscal Detail and Notes

This legislation will require a General Fund appropriation to the Correctional Medical Services Fund within the Department of Corrections of \$562,968 in fiscal year 2005-06 and \$840,699 in fiscal year 2006-07. This appropriation will provide additional funds for increased reimbursement rates for medical services provided to state inmates outside of correctional facilities.
