An Act To Require That Licensed Pastoral Counselors Be Recognized as Licensed Professionals for Purposes of Insurance Reimbursement

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 24-A MRSA §2744, as amended by PL 2003, c. 65, §1 and 4 affected by §5, is further amended to read:

6 §2744. Mental health services

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8 Notwithstanding any provision of a health insurance 1. policy subject to this chapter, whenever the policy provides for 10 payment or reimbursement for services that are within the lawful scope of practice of a psychologist licensed to practice in this 12 State; a certified social worker licensed for the independent practice of social work in this State who-has-at-least -a-masters 14 degree-in-social-work-from -an -accredited -educational-institution, has-been-employed-in-secial-work-for-at-least-2-years, -and-wher 16 after-January-17--1985--must--be--licensed-as--a-clinical-seeial worker-in-this-State; a licensed clinical professional counselor 18 licensed for the independent practice of counseling who-has-at least -- a-- masters -- degree -- in -- counseling -- from -- an -- accredited 20 educational-institution,-has-been-employed-in-counseling-for-at least-2-years and, after-January-1, -2002, -must-be-licensed as a 22 elinical--professional--counselor in this Stater; a licensed pastoral counselor licensed as a pastoral counselor in the State; 24 or a licensed nurse who is certified by the American Nurses' Association as a clinical specialist in adult psychiatric and mental health nursing or as a clinical specialist in child and 26 adolescent psychiatric and mental health nursing, any person covered by the policy is entitled to reimbursement for these 28 services if the services are performed by a physician; а psychologist licensed to practice in this State; a certified 30 social worker licensed for the independent practice of social 32 work who-has-at-least-a-masters-degree-in-social-work-from-an accredited--educational--institution/--who--has-been--employed--in secial-work-for-at-least-2-years, and who, after January-1, -1985, 34 must-be-licensed-as-a-elinical-social-werker in this State; a professional counselor licensed 36 licensed clinical for the independent practice of counseling who-has-at--least-a-masters degree-in-counseling-from-an-accredited-educational-institution, 38 has-been-omployed -in-counseling-for-at-least-2-years-and, after January--1, -- 2002, -- must--bo--licensed--as--a-clinical--professional 40 eeunseler in this State; a licensed pastoral counselor licensed as a pastoral counselor in this State; or a licensed nurse 42 certified by the American Nurses' Association as a clinical 44 specialist in adult or child and adolescent psychiatric and mental health nursing. Payment or reimbursement for services rendered by clinical social workers licensed in this State, 46 licensed clinical professional counselors licensed in this State, licensed pastoral counselors licensed in this State or licensed 48 nurses certified by the American Nurses' Association as clinical specialists in adult or child and adolescent psychiatric and 50

mental health nursing may not be conditioned upon prior diagnosis
or referral by a physician or other health care professional, except in cases where diagnosis of the condition for which the
services are rendered is beyond the scope of their licensure.

2. Nothing in subsection 1 may be construed to require a health insurance policy subject to this chapter to provide for reimbursement of services that are within the lawful scope of practice of a psychologist licensed to practice in this State, a
clinical social worker licensed in this State, a clinical professional counselor licensed to practice in this State, a
licensed pastoral counselor licensed in this State, a certified social worker licensed to practice in this State, or a certified nurse licensed to practice in this State.

16 3. Mental health services provided by counseling professionals. Except as provided in subsection 1 with regard to reimbursement of clinical professional counselors and pastoral 18 counselors licensed in this State, an insurer that issues individual health care contracts providing coverage for mental 20 health services shall offer coverage for those services when performed by a counseling professional who is licensed by the 22 State pursuant to Title 32, chapter 119 to assess and treat 24 interpersonal and intrapersonal problems, has at least a masters degree in counseling or a related field from an accredited 26 educational institution and has been employed as a counselor for Any contract providing coverage for the at least 2 years. services of counseling professionals pursuant to this section may 28 be subject to any reasonable limitations, maximum benefits, coinsurance, deductibles or exclusion provisions applicable to 30 overall benefits under the contract. This subsection applies to all contracts executed, delivered, issued for delivery, continued 32 or renewed in this State on or after January 1, 1997. For purposes of this subsection, all contracts are deemed renewed no 34 later than the next yearly anniversary of the contract date. 36

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Mental health services provided bv 3. counseling professionals. Except as provided in subsection 1 with regard to 2 reimbursement of clinical professional counselors and pastoral counselors licensed in this State, an insurer that issues group 4 health care contracts providing coverage for mental health services shall make available coverage for those services when 6 performed by a counseling professional who is licensed by the 8 State pursuant to Title 32, chapter 119 to assess and treat interpersonal and intrapersonal problems, has at least a masters degree in counseling or a related field from an accredited 10 educational institution and has been employed as a counselor for at least 2 years. Any contract providing coverage for the 12 services of counseling professionals pursuant to this section may be subject to any reasonable limitations, maximum benefits, 14 coinsurance, deductibles or exclusion provisions applicable to 16 overall benefits under the contract. This subsection applies to all policies, contracts and certificates executed, delivered, issued for delivery, continued or renewed in this State. 18 For purposes of this subsection, all contracts are deemed renewed no 20 later than the next yearly anniversary of the contract date.

Sec. 3. Application. This Act applies to all policies, contracts and certificates executed, delivered, issued for delivery, continued or renewed in this State on or after January 1, 2006. For purposes of this Act, all contracts are deemed to be renewed no later than the next yearly anniversary of the contract date.

SUMMARY

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This bill requires that all health care plans reimburse for mental health services provided by licensed pastoral counselors licensed in this State. The bill applies to all policies issued or renewed on or after January 1, 2006.

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
