Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 38 MRSA §1273. sub-§4. as amended by PL 1991, c. 473,
4 §12, is further amended to read:

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~~4. Exemption. Persons--undertaking--asbestos--abatement~~
~~activities--in--single--unit--residential--buildings--are--exempt--from~~
~~the--licensing--and--certification--requirements--of--this--section--if~~
~~the--activities--are--limited--to--heating--equipment--and--performed--by~~

12 ~~equipment.~~ Asbestos abatement activities related to disposal
14 undertaken at licensed asbestos disposal sites are exempt from
the requirements of this section.

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SUMMARY

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This bill requires that all persons engaging in asbestos
20 abatement activities, except asbestos abatement activities
related to disposal undertaken at licensed asbestos disposal
22 sites, be subject to licensing and certification requirements.
