	<u>A telephone utility may not retroactively bill a customer</u>
8	for services without the permission of that customer. For
	purposes of this section, "retroactively bill" means to bill for
10	services for the first time after the passage of the monthly or
	other regular billing cycle period in which those services would
12	normally have been billed. The commission may adopt appropriate
	rules or orders to implement this provision. Rules adopted
14	pursuant to this section are routine technical rules as defined
	in Title 5, chapter 375, subchapter 2-A.
