COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 51, L.D. 55

Sec. 1. Rules to be reviewed. Resolved: That the Department of 2 Health and Human Services shall review the rules regarding the responsibilities of hospitals and physicians in implementing the Uniform Anatomical Gift Act, including, but not limited to, the 4 congruity of the current rules with recent federal changes in the 6 protocol for organ and tissue procurement, informed consent, conflict of interest and the potential application of the rules to research facilities and other entities not currently subject 8 to the rules. The department shall include in the review 10 representatives of the Department of the Attorney General, Office of the Chief Medical Examiner, Maine hospitals, a regional organ 12 and tissue bank, a statewide association of funeral directors, a statewide association of funeral consumers and medical providers 14 involved in the organ and tissue procurement process. The department shall report by January 31, 2006 to the Joint Standing Committee on Health and Human Services regarding the review and 16 any recommendations of the department.

Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this resolve takes effect when approved.'

SUMMARY

This amendment replaces the bill with a resolve to have the Department of Health and Human Services review its rules for organ and tissue donation procurement. The resolve requires a report to the Joint Standing Committee on Health and Human Services by January 31, 2006. The amendment adds an emergency preamble and an emergency clause.
