**	SUMMARY

	This bill establishes procedures for the donation of all or
48	part of a human body for medical and dental research purposes
	when the donation is made to a research facility not already
50	covered by the provisions of the Uniform Anatomical Gift Act.
	The bill subjects donations to a research facility to provisions

of the Uniform Anatomical Gift Act, uses the definitions of that
act and imposes additional requirements regarding training,
documentation of the donation and recording of telephone
conversations with family members of the donor.
