2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 1 MRSA §151.** as amended by PL 1987, c. 769, Pt. B,
§1, is further amended to read:

6 **§151. "Standard Time"**

8 Within this State the standard time ~~shall be~~ is that which
10 is known and designated by the federal statute as "United States
Eastern Standard Time."

12 ~~At 2 o'clock antemeridian of the first Sunday in April of~~
14 ~~each year, the standard time in this State shall be advanced one~~
16 ~~hour, and at 2 o'clock antemeridian of the last Sunday in October~~
18 ~~of each year the standard time in this State, by the retarding of~~
20 ~~one hour, shall be made to coincide with the mean astronomical~~
22 ~~time of the degree of longitude governing the zone wherein the~~
24 ~~State is situated, the standard official time of which is~~
~~described as United States Eastern Standard Time, so that between~~
~~the first Sunday of April at 2 o'clock antemeridian and the last~~
~~Sunday in October at 2 o'clock antemeridian in each year the~~
~~standard time in this State shall be one hour in advance of the~~
~~United States Eastern Standard Time and said time shall be known~~
~~as "Eastern Daylight Time."~~
