An Act To Amend the Laws Governing the Funding of State Special Elections

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 21-A MRSA §633, as enacted by PL 1985, c. 161, §6, is amended to read:

6 §633. Election expenses; regular elections

8 Except for the added expenses incurred by a municipality under section 632, each municipality shall pay for the expense it 10 incurs in calling, holding and reporting the results of an a regular election as defined in section 1, subsection 39. The 12 State shall pay for other election expenses incurred as a result of the performance by state officials of their duties under this 14 Title.

16 Sec. 2. 21-A MRSA §633-A is enacted to read:

18 §633-A. Election expenses; special elections

20 The expenses each municipality incurs in calling, holding and reporting the results of a special election, as defined in 22 section 1, subsection 41, must be reimbursed by the State if the special election expenses are incurred by action of the State.

SUMMARY

28 This bill requires the State to pay the cost of holding special elections allowed by the Legislature by reimbursing 30 municipalities for the election costs directly incurred.
